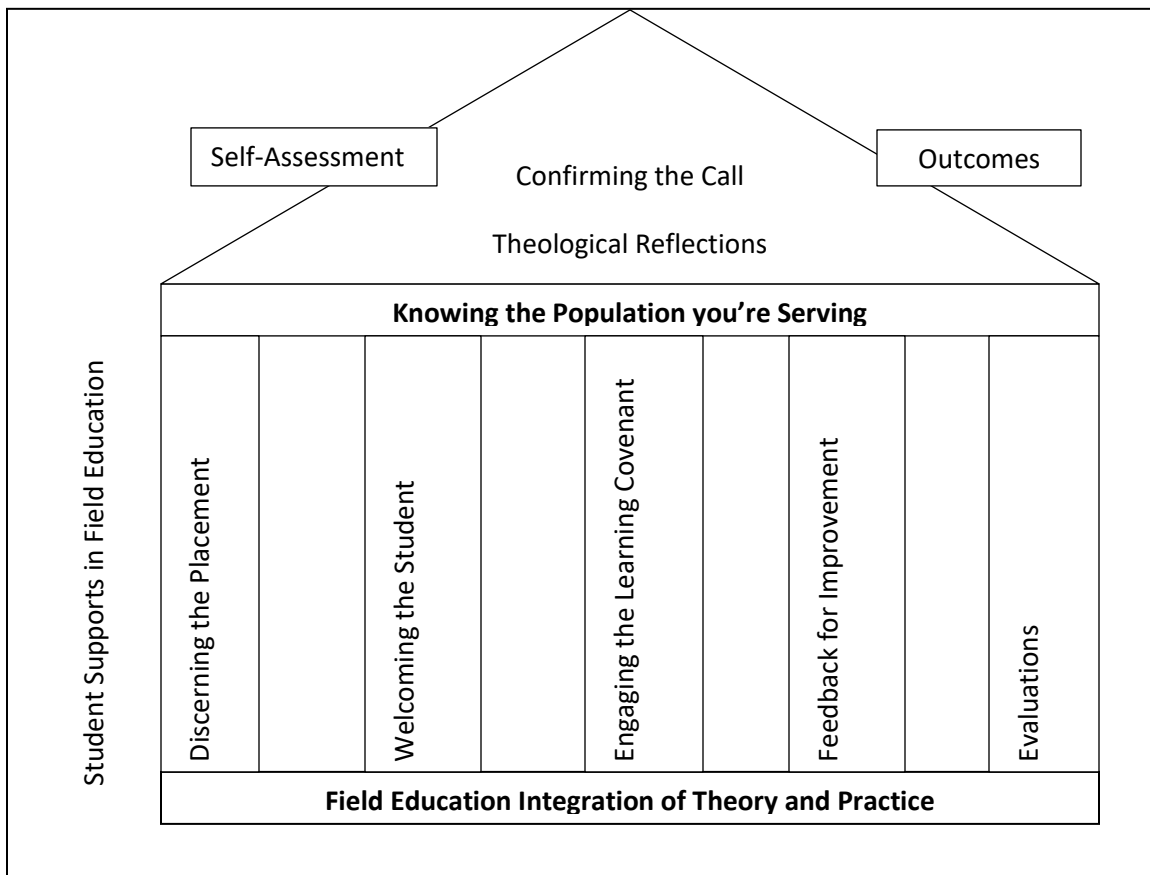


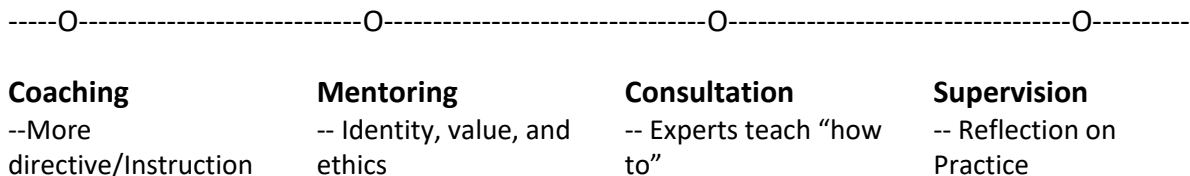
Building Blocks for Field Education
